Aim of the course — to improve the student's skills in Russian as a foreign language in everyday, socio-cultural and educational areas of communication.

Learning outcomes

A participant who has completed the course:

- 1. implements communication needs by interacting with native speakers of the Russian language in everyday, sociocultural, and educational areas of communication;
- 2. understands sufficiently the content of dialogue and monologue in everyday, sociocultural, and educational areas of communication (understands the topic, basic and additional information contained in the audio text, the communicative intentions of the author, etc.);
- 3. understands, interprets, and evaluates the content of authentic texts of everyday, sociocultural, and educational nature;
- 4. conveys the content, the main idea of the text read or listened to, expresses a personal attitude to the read.

Forms of independent work of students:

- completing situational-communicative tasks in pairs/groups, role-playing games;
- writing an essay on a given topic;
- preparation and presentation of an individual/group project within the studied topic;
- completing text assignments on the studied communicative topic in the Moodle environment;
- preparation and presentation of an individual message on a given communicative topic.

Form of assessment: oral testing


